विषय: संशोधित वेतन संरचना में नर्सिंग कैडर का प्रारंभिक वेतन निर्धारित करना - निर्धारण तालिका को परिपत्रित करने के संबंध में।

संदर्भ: बोर्ड के दिनांक 11.09.2008 एवं 22.09.2008 के पत्र सं. पीसी-VI/2008/आई/आरएसआरपी/1.

भारत सरकार द्वारा स्वीकृत छठे केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों के कार्यान्वयन के परिणामस्वरूप, रु. 7450-11500 एवं रु. 6500-10500 के संशोधन-पूर्व स्केल में मुख्य मैट्रन एवं मैट्रन के पदों को पीबी-3 (रु. 15600-39100) + ग्रेड पे रु. 5400 की संशोधित वेतन संरचना दी गई थी।

2. मौजूदा कर्मचारियों (1.1.2006 को पहले से सेवा में) के लिए जहां सामान्य प्रतिस्थापन वेतन संरचना निर्धारित की गई है, छठे केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की वेतन संरचना में प्रारंभिक वेतन निर्धारित करने के लिए निर्धारण तालिकाओं को बोर्ड के दिनांक 11.09.2008 के पत्र सं. पीसी-VI/2008/आई/आरएसआरपी/1 के अनुलग्नक 'ई' के रूप में जारी किया गया था। जहां अपग्रेडेड वेतन संरचना दी गई थी वहाँ वेतन निर्धारित करने की पद्धति के संबंध में दिनांक 11.11.2008 के पत्र सं. पीसी-VI/2008/आई/आरएसआरपी/1 के तहत अतिरिक्त स्पष्टीकरण जारी किए गए थे।

3. विभिन्न क्षेत्रीय रेलों से पत्र प्राप्त हुये थे जिनमें मुख्य मैट्रन/ मैट्रन के पदों (7450-11500 एवं 6500-10500 रुपए का संशोधन पूर्व स्केल) जहां संशोधन पूर्व स्केल में विभिन्न स्तर न्यूनतम वेतनमान-3 (रु. 15600) में एकत्रित हो रही थी, के लिए वेतन निर्धारित (बैंचिंग की सुविधा का उल्लेख करके) करने के लिए सही पद्धति से संबंधित आवश्यक स्पष्टीकरण/निर्धारण तालिकाएं मांगी गई हैं।

4. इस मंत्रालय के वित्त निदेशालय के परामर्श से इस मामले की जांच की गई है और तदनुसार, इस पत्र के साथ 6500-10500 एवं 7450-11500 के संशोधन पूर्व स्केल में मुख्य मैट्रन/ मैट्रन (15600-39100 के संशोधित वेतनमान + 5400 ग्रेड पे में रखा गया) के लिए छठे केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की वेतन संरचना में उक्त पदों के लिए प्रारंभिक वेतन निर्धारित करने के लिए प्रयोग हेतु अनंतिम निर्धारण तालिकाएं संलग्न हैं।

5. इसे इस मंत्रालय के वित्त निदेशालय की सहमति से जारी किया जा रहा है।



Sub: Fixation of initial pay of Nursing Cadre in the revised pay structure – Circulation of Fixation Tables reg.
Ref: Board's letters No. PC-VI/2008/I/RSRP/1 dated 11.09.2008 & 22.09.2008.

Consequent upon implementation of recommendations of 6th CPC as accepted by Govt. of India, posts of Chief Matron & Matron in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 7450-11500 & Rs. 6500-10500 were granted a revised pay structure of PB-3 (Rs. 15600-39100) + GP Rs. 5400.

2. Fixation tables were issued as Annexure 'E' to Board's letter No. PC-VI/2008/I/RSRP/1 dated 11.09.2008 for fixation of initial pay in 6th CPC pay structure in respect of existing employees (already in service as on 1.1.2006) in cases where normal replacement pay structure were prescribed. Further clarifications were issued vide letter No. PC-VI/2008/I/RSRP/1 dated 11.11.2008 regarding methodology for fixation of pay where upgraded pay structure were given.
3. References were received from various Zonal Railways seeking necessary clarification/fixation tables regarding correct methodology for fixation of pay (indicating benefit of bunching) for the posts of Chief Matron/ Matron (pre-revised scale of Rs. 7450-11500 & 6500-10500) where various stages in pre-revised scales are getting bunched at minimum of PB-3 (Rs. 15600).
4. The matter has been examined in consultation with Finance Dte of this Ministry and accordingly, provisional fixation tables in respect of Chief Matron/ Matron in the pre-revised scale of 6500-10500 & 7450-11500 (placed in revised pay scale of 15600-39100 + GP 5400) are annexed herewith for utilizing the same for initial pay fixation in 6th CPC pay structure for the above posts.
5. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of this Ministry.
