#### OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Grievance pertains to non implementation of the provisions of RPwD Act, 2016/guidelines of DoPT/order of CCPD by various Ministries/Departments of Central Government-reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to a grievance submitted by Shri P Mathew, a PwBD activist in Madhya Pradesh (enclosed) on the subject mentioned above raising the issue of alleged nonimplementation of the provisions of RPwD Act, 2016/guidelines of DoPT/order of CCPD regarding 'Equal Opportunity Policy' and 'Appointment of Grievance Redressal Officer' by various Ministries/Departments of Central Government.

- Relevant Sections of the RPwD Act, 2016 are reproduced as under: 2.
  - Section 21: Equal opportunity policy.—(1) Every establishment shall notify equal opportunity policy detailing measures proposed to be taken by it in pursuance of the provisions of this Chapter in the manner as may be prescribed by the Central Government.
    - (2) Every establishment shall register a copy of the said policy with the Chief Commissioner or the State Commissioner, as the case may be.
  - Section 23: Appointment of Grievance Redressal Officer.—(1) Every Government establishment shall appoint a Grievance Redressal Officer for the purpose of section 19 and shall inform the Chief Commissioner or the State Commissioner, as the case may be, about the appointment of such officer.

(2) Any person aggrieved with the non-compliance of the provisions of section 20, may file a complaint with the Grievance Redressal Officer, who shall investigate it and shall take up the matter with the establishment for corrective action.

(3) The Grievance Redressal Officer shall maintain a register of complaints in the manner as may be prescribed by the Central Government, and every complaint shall be inquired within two weeks of its registration.

(4) If the aggrieved person is not satisfied with the action taken on his or her complaint, he or she may approach the District-Level Committee on disability.

All Ministries/Departments are advised to ensure compliance with the above provisions of the RPwD Act, 2016.

Resected sir,

In this regard, it is humbly submitted that Ministries/Departments of Gentral Government have repeatedly violated guidelines of DoFT /Provisions of FwD Act,1995 and RPwD Act, 2016/Non implementation of order of CCPD as issued by the DoF&T from time to time due to which eligible FwDBs employees of the Ministries/Departments of Central Government have been deprived from their rights for which they are legally entitled and Ministries/Departments of Central Government are neither ready to accept their mistake nor laking any action to rectify mistake committed which is not in order in view of proviso of PwD Act, 1995 effective from 07.02.1996 & Rights with PwD Act, 2016 effective from 19.04.2017 on the plea that they have no directions from their HQ not only for the implementation of "Reservation in Promotion" from 20.11.1989 on promotion to Group-D, Group-C and within-C posts but also subsequent provisions in connection with "Reservation in Promotion" and they are anable/will not implement the provision of these acts until & unless directions from the Ministries/Departments of Central Government is received for the implementation of mandatory provisions under the relevant legal acts. The Ministries/Departments are also saying that they have not directions form the DoFT in this regard which is not correct at all as DoF&T has already issued crystal clear guidelines in this and onus for implementation these directions of DoP&T lies with Ministries/Departments only.

Non-compliance of the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court acted 26.03.2014 as circulated by the Olion'ble Chief Commissioner Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide Deletter No 4-1/CCD/2009 (Vol-II)/R4540 dated 27.06.2014 in connection with the implementation of each & every provision of "The Fersons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Italian Participation) Act. 1995" including "Reservation in Promotion" under Section-33 by the end of 2014 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.116 of 1998-Justice Sunanda Bhandare Foundation Vs. Union of India & Ors. No "Reservation in promotion" is not implanted by Ministrics/Departments of Central Government since 20.11.1989.

10. Non providing of "Reservation in promotion" on promotion of PwBDs official to the post of Group-D, Group-C and within Group-C @ 3% for the period 20.11.1989 to 18.04.2017 in terms of DOFT OM dated 20.11.1989 & 29.12.2005 r/w PwD Act, 1995 and @4% for the period 19.04.2017 to 31.12.2022 in view of DoFT OM dated 15.01.2018 r/w-RPwD Act, 2016.

Non implementation of above provisions are crystal clear violations of PwD Act, 1995 and Rights PwD Act, 2016 which is not permissible by any Departments/Ministries but still they are doing not only since 1995 but also from 2016 to till date which a matter great concern and also painful since Government of India has mandate to provide the retief to PwBDs and India was first a signatory to the United Nations Convention on Rights of Persons with Disabilities held in 2007.

### B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE LIAISON OFFICERS: The Liaison Officer is responsible for:

- I. Ensuring due compliance by the Ministry/ Department and subordinate appointing authorities with the orders and instructions pertaining to the reservation of vacancies in favour of the category for which, he/she is a liaison officer i.e. Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Persons with Disabilities, Other Backward Classes, Economically Weaker Sections and Exservicemen. In addition, he/she shall also ensure that other benefit admissible to them are made available to them.
- vi. Conducting annual inspection of the reservation registers/rosters maintained in the Ministry/Department/Offices under the control of the Ministry/Department with a view to ensuring proper implementation of the reservation orders.

#### D. PRIVILEGES OF THE LIAISON OFFICER:

Cases of negligence or lapse in the matter of following the reservation and other orders relating to SC, ST, OBCs, PwDs, EWS and Ex-servicemen coming to the light through the inspections carried out by the Liaison Officer, or otherwise shall be reported/submitted by him direct to the Secretary/Additional Secretary to the Government of India in the respective Ministry/ Department or to the Head of the Department in respect of offices under the Heads of Department, as the case may be. The concerned Secretary/Additional Secretary/Head of the Department shall pass necessary orders on such reports to ensure strict compliance of the reservation orders by the appointing authority concerned.

F. SPECIAL RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE LIAISON OFFICERS OF THE MINISTRIES/DEPARTMENTS TOWARDS IMPLEMENTATION OF RESERVATION POLICIES IN THE ESTABLISHMENTS UNDER THE GOVERNMENT:

"The Liaison Officer of a Ministry/Department has to act as Liaison Officer in respect of the matters relating to the representation SCs/STs/PwDs, OBCs, Ex-servicemen and EWS in all establishments and services under the administrative control of the Ministry/Department. The appointment of Liaison Officers separately by the Organizations under the Government of India such as Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory and Senii Government Bodies, Autonomous Bodies/ Institutions, including Municipal Corporations, Co-operative Institutions, Universities, Voluntary Agencies receiving grants in aid from the Government etc. does not, however, dilute or alter or curtail the responsibilities of the Liaison Officers of the administrative Ministry/ Department with regard to implementation of reservation policy in such organizations. Liaison Officers of the Ministries/ Departments have special responsibility to monitor implementation of reservation policies in these organizations. In order to ensure due compliance of the reservation orders of the Government, the Liaison Officers may periodically visit/ inspect the offices/organizations under them.

without any gap in the entries made in the rosters. Liaison Officers shall carry out their duties in relation to reservation by calling for records from them and convening meetings with the officers of such organizations as are responsible for ensuring reservation policies in their respective organizations. If Liaison Officers of Ministries/Departments notice that reservation instructions are not being followed orders/instructions to harm the interests of the above-mentioned categories, are received they should concerned without fear & hesitation of hierarchical disobedience".

It is also submitted that that recently a PIL was decided by the Hon'ble High Court vide their Judgment on 06.03.2023 vide WF [C] 8455/2017 in the matter of National Federation of the Blind-from Skri S K Rungta, Senior Advocate Vs. GOVT. OF NCT OF DELHI from which it was emerged that:

In the nutshell, with the efforts of Shri R K Rungta, Senior Advocate, 2193 have been emerged in which "Reservation in Direct Recuirtment-1351 Posts" and "Reservation in Promotion-842 Posts" will be provided to PwBD officials in "Government of Delhi" through DPC/DSSSB/UPSC as the case may be within next two months. The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has also appreciates the genuine and sincere efforts as taken by Shri.S.K. Rungta, Senior Advocate, who has selflessly taken up the case of protecting the interests of Specially Abled Persons. On the same pattern, if this exercise is taken in each Ministries/Departments, I am sure that so many vacancies can be emerged for PwBDs from 20.11.1989 to 2022 which belongs to Group-C and Group-D not only under "Direct Recruitment" but also under "Promotion Quota" as "Backlog Vacancies" for PwBDs Officials.

In view of above facts, it is humbly requested that necessary may kindly be taken into the case for the settlement for the above grievances and strict implementations of all relevant provisions of DOPT OMs/PwD Act, 1995/RPwD Act, 2016 including "Reservation in Promotion" on promotion to Group-D and Group-C in which percentage of Direct Recruitment does not exceed 75% as noted above, since for the implementation of legal provisions of either DOPT OMs or PwD Act, 1995 or RPwD Act, 2016, any kind of decision making is not required by the Ministries/Departments of Central Government since the decision has already been taken by the DOPT as well as by the Hon'ble legislature by passing the PwD Act, 1995 & RPwD Act, 2016 except to take the decision how to implementation the provisions in the Departments/Ministries especially "Reservation in Promotion" on promotion of PwBDs official to the post of Group-D, Group-C and within Group-C @ 3% for the period 20.11.1989 to 18.04.2017 in terms of DOPT OM dated 20.11.1989 & 29.12.2005 r/w PwD Act, 1995 and @4% for the period 19.04.2017 to with the consequential benefit of "Deemed date of Promotion" from the date on which PwBDs is supposed to promote under "Reservation in Promotion" as per their eligibility as recently implemented by the Haryana Government in the year-2022.
