Regional Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), Imphal, set up in 1972, has been functioning under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare since 1st April, 2007. It is an Institute of regional importance catering to the needs of the North Eastern Region in the field of medical education by providing undergraduate and post-graduate courses. It has a teaching Hospital with more than 1229 beds, equipped with modern state-of-the-art equipment and teaching facilities, a Dental College and a Nursing College. The Hospital normally provides services to more than 4.4 lakh out-door patients, 1.3. lakh emergency cases and admits over 38 thousand patients in a year.

The Institute has a Board of Governor headed by Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare as the President and an Executive Council headed by the Secretary, Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India as the chairman.

The Board of Governors is the highest authority of the Institute, which has the power to do all necessary acts for the attainment and administration of the objectives of the Institute. The Executive Council is responsible for supervising the overall administration and management of the institute, review of the finance, approval of the academic, scientific and technical programmes, framing Bye-laws and procedures for conduct of the affairs of the Institute etc.

The Director, RIMS, Imphal acts as Head of all academic, scientific and administrative functions of the Institute and is the overall in-charge of day today affairs of the Institute. The Medical Superintendent is the overall in-charge of the RIMS hospital, who looks after its day to day functioning of the teaching Hospital. The functioning of the Dental College, Nursing College and different medical specialties is directly under the respective Principals/ Heads of the Department.
